

Brook Bank Shooting Ground – Rules & Regulations:

1. All cars are parked at owner's risk.
2. All dogs to be kept on a lead and exercised only in the permitted area with the management's permission. No visitor's dogs are allowed in the lodge.
3. All visitors, please report to reception on arrival.
4. No unauthorised persons to interfere with clay traps.
5. No person may 'instruct' without permission from the management.
6. Shotguns to be secured in owner's cars when not in use – do not bring guns into the lodge.
7. All guns to be kept broken, except, when in a cage or on a shooting stand.
8. Semi-automatic shotguns, are to be sleeved or 'flagged' when not in use.
9. Only Hull & Fiocchi cartridges may be used for practice on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday & Saturdays.
10. Ear protection to be worn by all shooters and shooting spectators.
11. We strongly recommend the use of eye protection.
12. Maximum load cartridges to be used are 28gr, shot size 6.
13. Steel shot is not permitted at Brook Bank – includes Registered competitions.
14. Shooting of any live animals/birds is strictly forbidden.
15. Only food purchased on the premises, to be consumed in the lodge.
16. Ear & eye protection is available from reception for spectators.
17. Only Wesley Hann Gunsmiths is permitted to sell shotguns & ammunition on the Brook Bank shooting ground site - variation to RFD Certificate (Avon & Somt D469) granted.
